Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to inform you that Mrs Whitlock has taken the decision to step down from her role as SENDCO.

I am pleased to reassure you that Mrs Whitlock will remain at Campion as a highly valued member of our teaching staff and as an intervention tutor. She will continue to work closely with many of the students she has previously supported, ensuring continuity, stability and ongoing care for those who know her well. We are very grateful for the dedication and commitment she has shown in her leadership of SEND provision.

Following a thorough recruitment process, we have appointed Miss Kayll as our new Assistant Principal for Inclusion. Miss Kayll has served as a SENDCO for the past three years in a large secondary school in Milton Keynes and brings with her a wealth of experience and expertise in leading inclusive practice. She will join Campion after the May half term, and we very much look forward to welcoming her to our community.

In the interim period, Mr Ellis, Vice Principal for Quality of Education, will oversee all aspects of SEND provision. He will be supported by Mrs Ridgard, Deputy SENDCO, and Mrs White, Assistant SENDCO. We will also continue to work closely with Miss Creamer, our independent SEND adviser, who has provided valuable support to the school over recent years.
