Dear Parent/Carer

Culture Day – Friday 27th March 2026

We will be celebrating Culture Day at Campion School on Friday 27th March 2026.

The aim of Culture Day is for students to celebrate and share aspects of culture, identity and heritage across our school community. This can include national culture, family heritage, traditions, interests, places students have visited, or things that represent British culture and everyday life.

Students have a number of options for clothing:

- **Traditional or cultural clothing that represents their heritage or family background.**
Examples: a sari, salwar kameez, dashiki, kilt, hanbok, dirndl, thobe, boubou, traditional Caribbean dress, or clothing worn for cultural celebrations.
- **Souvenir clothing from places they have visited.**
Examples: a “I ❤️ New York” T-shirt, a hoodie from Paris, a Barcelona football shirt bought on holiday, a Dubai or Rome souvenir T-shirt, or clothing from Disneyland or other international destinations.
- **Clothing in the colours of a national flag.**
Examples: red, white and blue for the UK, green/white/orange for Ireland, red and yellow for Spain, red and white for Canada, or black/red/yellow for Germany.
- **Sports shirts or items linked to cultural identity.**
Examples: England, Scotland or Wales football shirts; Brazil or Argentina football shirts; a cricket jersey; rugby team shirts; or clothing representing national teams during international tournaments.

Important guidance:

- Clothing must still be appropriate for a school environment.
- Outfits should be respectful and not offensive to any culture, religion or group.

The key message is that there is no single “correct” way to represent culture, and participation can be as simple or creative as students wish. Students are encouraged to simply celebrate their identity in a way that feels meaningful to them.

Thank you for your support in helping us make the day a positive celebration of the diversity within our school community.
