Dear Parents and Carers,

We are really proud of Campion students who routinely show their integrity by making excellent choices about their conduct outside of the school building. This includes when travelling on the school buses, walking to and from school, and when in the community in our uniform and representing the school. They are a real credit to our school, and to you.

We would like to take this opportunity to highlight to students and families that schools have the power to discipline beyond the school gate and apply sanctions where a student has misbehaved off-site when representing the school. This means misbehaviour when the student is:

- Taking part in any school-organised or school-related activity e.g. educational visits, sports fixture
- Travelling to or from school
- Wearing school uniform
- In any other way identifiable as a student of our school

Sanctions may also be applied where a student has misbehaved off-site, at any time, whether or not the conditions above apply, if the misbehaviour:

Could have repercussions for the orderly running of the school

- Could adversely affect the reputation of the school. This will include any instances of cyberbullying or misuse of social media.

These features of our behaviour policy are designed to support the good order and smooth operation of the school, as well as to support the reputation of the school and all individuals who are part of our community.

With this in mind, we would be grateful if parents/carers would discuss this with their children with particular emphasis on behaviour when on school buses and when in the community. We are grateful when students and parents/carers share with us information where Campion students have not behaved with the highest integrity – rest assured we will always follow this up and act accordingly.
