Fidget Toys in School

We have a number of children in school who benefit from the use of school approved 'fidget rings / bands' to support focus or anxiety management in the classroom. These items have been issued following consultation between home and our inclusion team, and their use is monitored by our teaching team.

Only items issued by the school, or approved by our inclusion team, are permitted in classrooms. However, over the last week, we have seen a number of students bringing their own 'fidget toys' into school and these have included the 'Needoh Nice Fidget Cube'.

These items are not permitted in school; particularly as we have had instances of the 'Needoh Nice Fidget Cube' popping and creating a mess in classrooms. The disruption to learning caused by instances like this is something that we want to avoid. Your support in ensuring that items of this nature are not brought into school would be greatly appreciated.
