



Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for the support you have been offering your children and the school. In particular I would like to thank parents/carers who have provided lots of feedback on the current behaviour policy and systems. We will be able to share a new policy with you very soon — alongside this I would like to invite parents/carers into school so we can explain the changes and rationale behind them — further details to follow.

I would like to thank the vast majority of children who just *get it right* every day. They are a credit to themselves and you as parents/carers. We are developing new systems to ensure that they are routinely praised every day for the excellent choices they make.

We have been leading assemblies in school this week, so pupils are aware of the expectations of school for the remaining few weeks ahead of the summer holiday. In the last few weeks of term please can you support us in encouraging your child to:

- Model the school values (Ambition, Respect, Integrity, Resilience)
- Attend all lessons punctually, taking an active part in the learning
- Wear correct uniform (reminder regarding jewellery one pair of stud earrings only)
- Mobile phones off and away
- Follow instructions of staff without delay

Regarding these particular areas, that support school to be safe, calm and orderly, there is no need for these to become areas of debate between pupils and staff. We are always pleased when pupils make good choices about their conduct and behaviour and of course, children will make mistakes sometimes, we would just ask that they accept any support, and sanctions if needed, in an appropriate way.

Please do continue to feel free to provide us feedback on areas you feel we can improve upon.
