Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware, Year 11 mock examinations for all subjects will be taking place during the week commencing **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2026**. This letter outlines the Science provision and how you can support your child with their preparation.

### Revision Information

Your child is following either the **AQA GCSE Biology, Chemistry and Physics (Triple Science)** course or the **AQA Combined Science: Trilogy** course.

In these mock examinations, students will sit **Paper 2** in each science subject – chemistry, physics and biology.
