Dear Parent/Carer

Your son/daughter's full progress report is now accessible via the online reporting system. The link for this service can be found at the bottom of the Campion School's homepage <http://www.campion.northants.sch.uk>

Please when viewing your son/daughter's report, click into the actual assessment report before looking at the data on the CMIS home page so you see the full report.

There is comment on the report of the progress your child is making and this should give you an indication as to whether your son/daughter is likely to reach their end of Key Stage 3 target (the end of KS3 is the end of Year 9 for English, Maths, Science, PE and ICT and the end of Year 8 for all other subjects). The descriptors will give you a clearer understanding of the comments.

Your son/daughter will be discussing their progress report with their form tutor and/or learning mentor to ensure that in any subjects which they are in danger of not reaching their target, they understand what actions they need to take to improve their progress in that subject. Your son/daughter will have a paper copy of their progress report in their student planner.


If you have specific questions about your son/daughter's progress in a certain subject, please contact the subject teacher directly. If you have more general questions about the progress report format or about your son/daughter's progress in general, please contact your son/daughter's form tutor. As you should be aware, Progress review Day for Y9 is Wednesday 6th January.

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that the Year 8 Option evening will take place on Thursday 14th January. More information will follow shortly but I would like to stress that this evening is important as it will enable you and your child to find out about the curriculum courses that will available to them in Year 9.

We are also changing our data management systems and this will affect the way you will be able to view information about your child. Our aim is to improve our reporting systems. Again information will be sent to you shortly.
