Year 11 Mock exams

I would like to take this opportunity to inform you that your child will be completing a second cycle of Science mock papers in the New Year.

The new Science exam specification comprises of six papers, two for each subject Biology paper 1 & 2, Chemistry paper 3 & 4 and Physics paper 5 & 6. Papers 1, 3 & 5 were completed in November and papers 2, 4 & 6 will be completed in the New Year.
