Dear Parent/ Carer

Your son/daughter's progress report is now accessible via the online reporting system. The Progresso link can be found at the bottom of the Campion School's homepage <http://www.campion.northants.sch.uk>. A full report will be issued after mock exams that take place in the next half term, although the actual mock results will be sent to you before Christmas.

This progress report contains a target grade for the end of Key Stage 4. You may notice that these have changed from the Y10 reports. This is because we use a national database to issue our targets and this has updated. With the changes to the new grading systems for GCSEs, the initial targets have been refined since the first actual grades have been awarded. As you are aware, we set targets at a high, aspirational figure and therefore believe it is appropriate to review the targets so that we are still in line with national expectations. I have explained this to students in assembly this week. The attainment level on the report is an indication of the level at which your son/daughter is currently working. In addition, there are judgements regarding effort, behaviour and completion of homework.

Your son/daughter will be discussing their progress report with their tutor to ensure that in any subjects where they are in danger of not reaching their target, they understand what actions they need to take to improve their progress.

Next week we have our Information Evening on Wednesday 17th October, regarding preparation for mocks and ways in which we can work together to support your child during this important year. In addition, we have a Parents' Evening on Thursday 1st November. This will be the first of two that we are hoping you can attend during this academic year. Students will be given appointment sheets shortly.
